

## **RIDER Tyfon©Organ and The Helperin Brothers Travel:**

Transport / setup of the Tyfon©Organ (1 100 kg) 24 hours before gig. And two person in Tyfon trailer. ( together 2 800 kg ) Shipping and/or flight. 16 amp power to the Tyfon©Organ. Checking the wireless midi system. The arranger is responsible for all needed permits. The volume can be up to 143db one meter from the horns. Needed safty area is a circle of 10-15 meters between the organ and the audience. Two guards are needed to check the safety area during the soundcheck and gig. Guard required for security all day and night time.

- **PA / monitors** 2 line box, tap from our one mixer.
- **Monitor:** 2 system/2 speakers front monitors.
- **Hotel:** 2 single rooms in a nice \*\*\* without any nearby nightclub/disco.
- **Back room:** 4 bottles of mineral water and some fresh fruits and snacks. Watchman for safety store during the gigs, soundcheck and remaining time when the artists not use the back room.
- **Food:** 2 kosher or vegetarian. With mineral water and some beers/wine. Diner can be at the hotel or in the back room, assume it´s a nice and calm surroundings. Time for diner in separate agreement for every gig.
  
- **World Wide Wind Ensemble,** apart from the TyfonOrgan, Transport of 4 persons. Car, train, shipping and/or flight.
- **PA / monitors** 2 line box, tap from our one mixer.
- **Monitor:** 2 system/4 speakers.
- **Hotel:** 4 single rooms in a nice \*\*\* without any nearby nightclub/disco.
- **Back room:** 8 bottles of mineral water, some beers and some fresh fruits and snacks. Watchman for safety store during the gigs, soundcheck and remaining time when the artists not use the back room.
- **Food:** (between sound check and gig) 1 ordinary and 3 kosher or vegetarian. With mineral water and some beers/wine. Diner can be at the hotel or in the back room, assume it´s a nice and calm surroundings. Time for diner in separate agreement for every gig.
